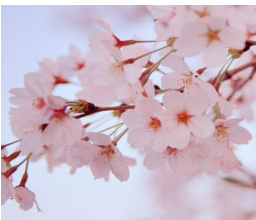
February 18(Sat) Komuroyama Camellia Show
